EYFS Curriculum

- In Nursery, we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum.
- It is broken down into:
 - Communication and Language
 - Physical Development
 - Personal, Social and Emotional Development
 - Literacy
 - Mathematics
 - Understanding the World
 - Expressive Arts and Design
 - Characteristics of Effective Learning

EYFS Curriculum

- We track and monitor each and every child's progress during their time in Nursery.
- Each child has a Profile of work which we gather during their time with us. This helps us adapt our curriculum to ensure ALL children have access to high quality learning opportunities.
- This Profile is then taken home at the end of their time in Nursery.

Important!!

- Please ensure your child's book bag is emptied each evening as we do send letters home regularly - as well as your child's masterpieces they may have made during the day!
- Please also ensure that you inform the School Office of any changes made, eg. change of address, medication, emergency contacts.
- Please make sure your child's name is on EVERY piece of clothing!!

Talking of clothing....

- Please ensure that your child has a change of clothes (especially underwear) in school as accidents can and do happen. We only have a limited amount of spare clothing to give home.
- Could you please also encourage your child to dress/undress themselves as this helps us **HUGELY** when we are having PE and coming into and going home from Nursery.

Sticker Charts

- We know that our children respond well to praise, so, as well as the School Dojo system, we reward our children with stickers. Stickers are given out for excellent behaviour, attitude, tidying, showing kindness and care and many other reasons.
- Once your child has the certain amount of stickers, they can choose a prize from our Prize Box - very exciting!

Home/School Relationships

Busy Books

- This is a parent/school relationship book which will have activities in it for your child to complete.
- It will be given out on the last session of the week for your child and needs to be returned the following week.

Library Books

- Your child can choose a Library Book to bring home each week.
- Please ensure that **ONLY** their Library Book is put in the plastic book bag!
