# Rules and Routines

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At the beginning of the year we will spend a lot of time making the children aware of the rules and routines that we have in the Early Years Unit.

# Letters and Sounds

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We follow the Letters and Sounds scheme for the teaching of phonics.

Due to missing the end of Nursery we will recap phase one as a class.

Once we start Letters and Sounds homework relating to the sounds learnt will be sent home on a Friday.

# English

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In addition to our Letters and Sounds teaching we will also have daily English sessions. We will read and explore a text, and then do a piece of work around this in small group sessions.

# Mathematics

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This year we are following the White Rose Scheme for Mathematics, as do the rest of school.

Maths sessions will be taught whole class, we will then do small group sessions as a follow up and Mathematical concepts can then be explored further within our Continuous Provision.

Maths Homework may be sent home from time to time.

# Homework

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Reading books – Once children are given a book with words in they will be expected to read three times a week. Each time your child reads with you, please can you ensure that you sign in their reading record book, this is the only way that their book can be changed.

Letters and Sounds – Each week I will send home words which contain the sounds that we have been learning in our Letters and Sounds work. These words are to be practiced at home as an extension of what we have been learning.

Mathematics – Maths homework will be sent home as and when necessary.

I will always provide any information needed with the homework sent home as well as any dates it is due to be returned.



# Parental Involvement

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Parental Involvement is vital for us to create a whole picture of what your child is capable of.

Being on the Class Dojo app and checking with it regularly is essential. This is the main way we will communicate with parents and in the event of home learning having to take place again Class Dojo will be the main channels of communication.

Please send pictures or Dojo messages of things that your child gets up to as parental involvement is vital in Early Years.

# PE

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Reception Class will have their PE sessions on a Tuesday morning.

Please can you make sure that your child comes to school in their PE kit (Shorts or jogging bottoms, t-shirt and a jacket or hoodie and trainers) Please make sure all items of clothing are labelled with your child's name.
