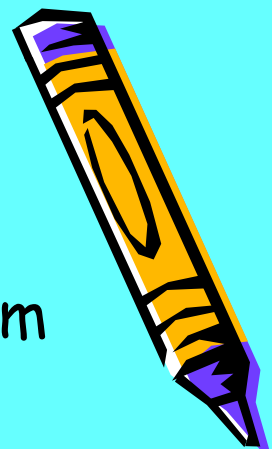


Daily routines

- Reading books changed everyday if they have been signed.



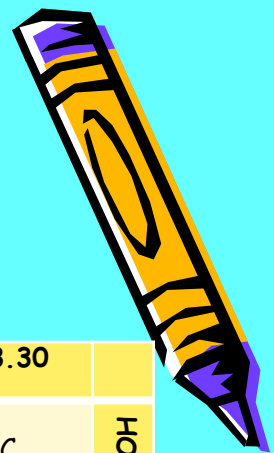
Reading



- Reading Records- must be completed a minimum of three times a week-acknowledgement of reading at home from parents/carers.
- Reading Records, have a list of Common Exception Word - in order to get 'Expected' the children need to be able to read, understand the meaning and spell the words-children will be tested on this throughout the year and a record of their scores will be put in the Reading Records for home to see. School will also keep a record of the scores to help teacher make the assessment judgement at the end of the year.

Handwriting



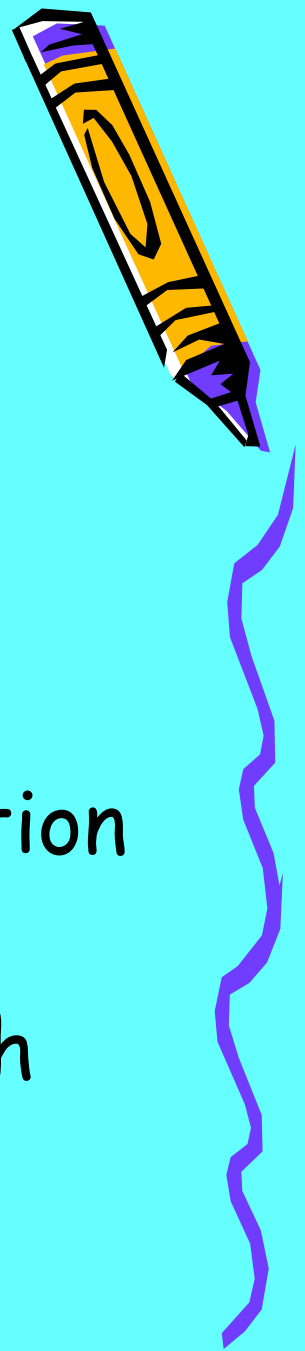
In Year 1 we write using pre-cursive which involves a flick at the beginning and end of each letter. - take home letter formation card.

- Each day the children will be introduced to a new word. Remember to ask your child what the word of the day is and can they say it in a sentence.

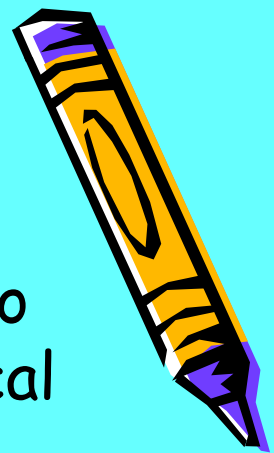

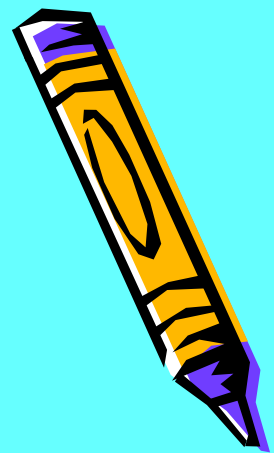
Reminder
