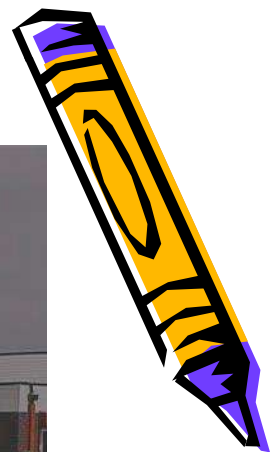

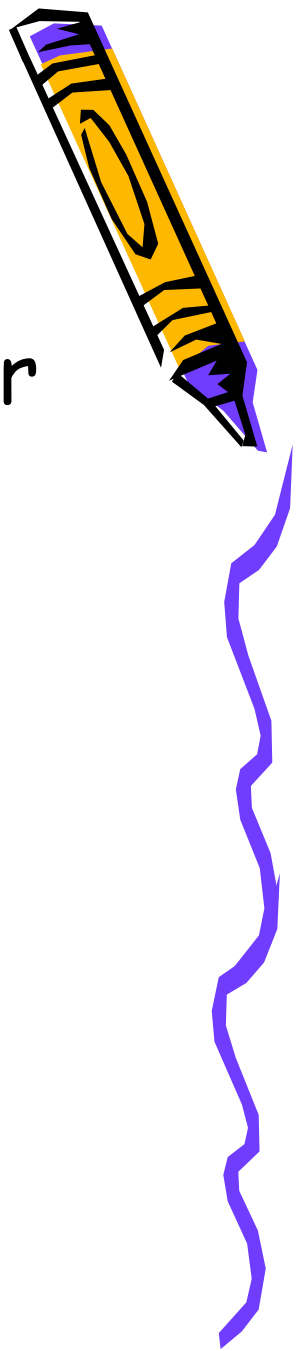

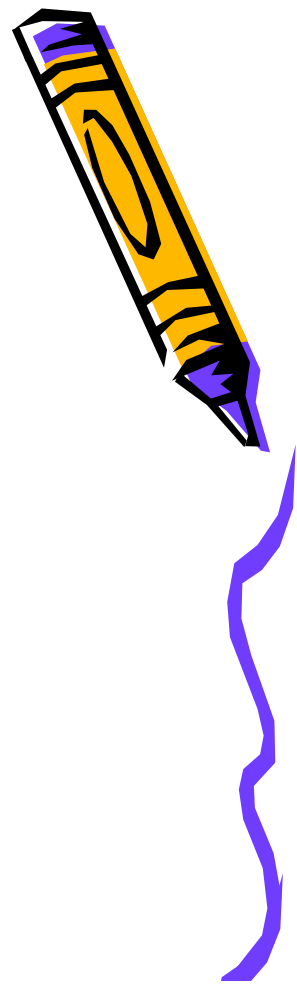


Who's Who?

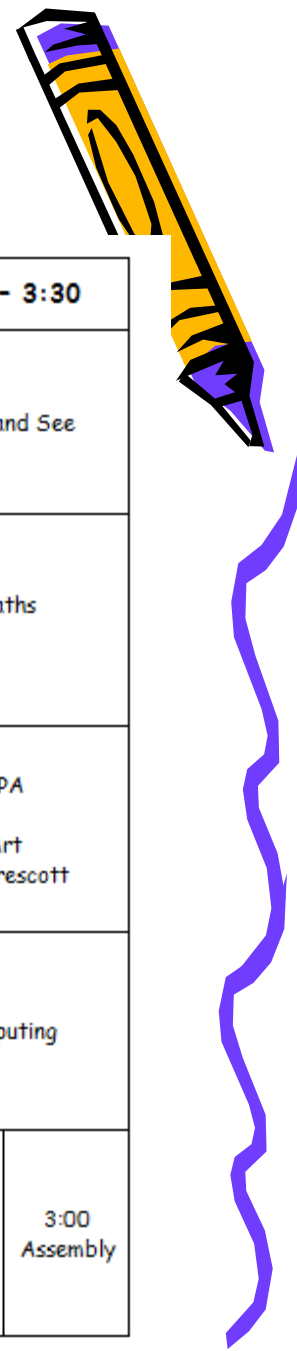

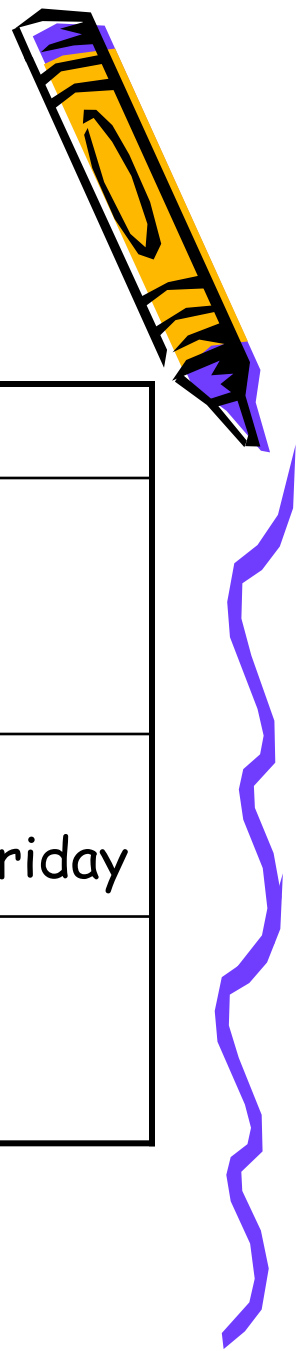

- Activities set up as stations on the playground.



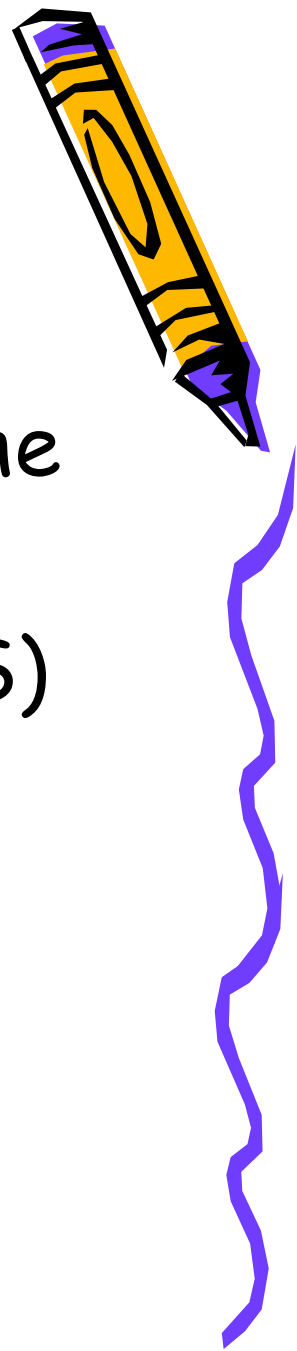
P.E.

- Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.



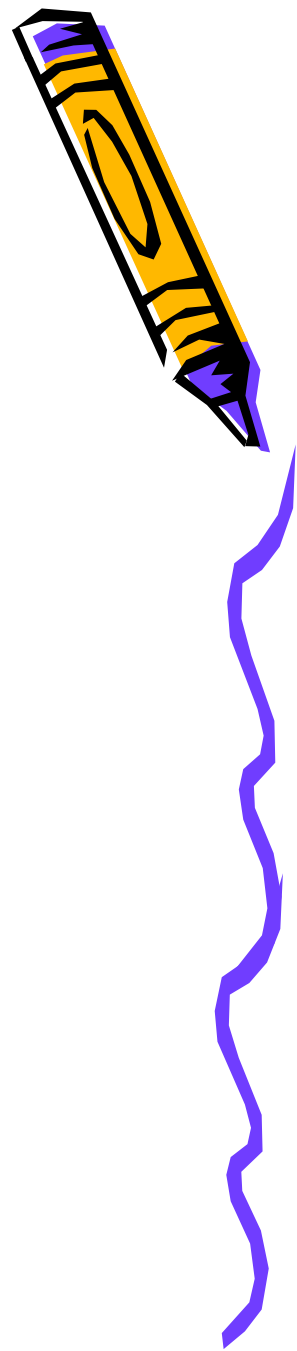
Assessments

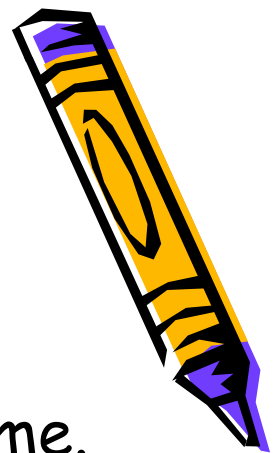
HAPPY BIRTHDAY !

- Please ensure the money is in an envelope, clearly labelled with the amount enclosed and your child's name.



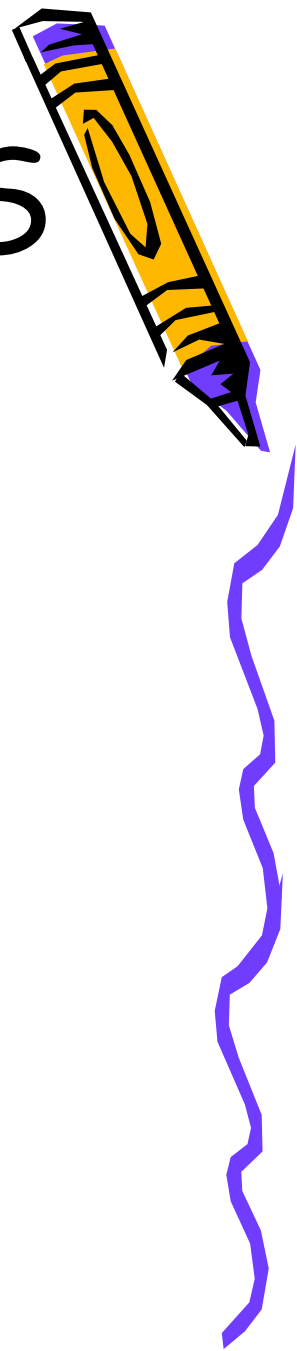

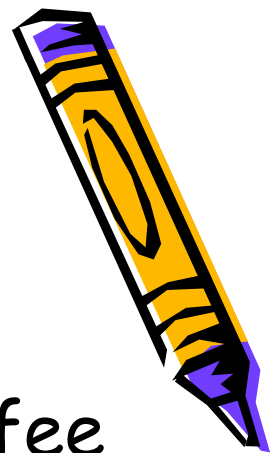
