Dear Parents/Carers,

As we embark on a new, exciting school year, we are taking the opportunity to update you on our behaviour rewards and sanctions at Holy Family.

We will continue to use the dojo rewards system used last year, where children will be given a dojo for demonstrating positive behaviour such as; trying their best, being active learners, being helpful friends, following instructions and treating everyone and everything with respect. This behaviour is one that we encourage all staff and parents/carers to also demonstrate: being positive role models is fundamental in embedding positive behaviour. When a child has received 100 dojos, they will be given a bronze star badge, once they have earned 200 dojos they will be awarded a silver star badge and when they reach 300 dojos, they will be given a gold star badge.

We will also continue to use the dojo system to inform you of any negative behaviour. As a consequence for poor behaviour choices, children may be spoken to by a class teacher, they may have to stay in at playtime/dinner time or if a more severe incident occurs, Mrs Taberner or Miss Crawley will deal with the child(ren) involved.

We have also adapted our Holy Family High Five:

1. 100% attendance
2. No lates
3. Reading or Reading plus completed 3 times a week – evidenced in the children's planners/reading records, signed by an adult and the children themselves
4. All homework completed
5. Full school uniform, including no jewellery and appropriate footwear

If a child demonstrates this on a weekly basis, they will collect ticks on a chart kept by the class teacher. At the end of every half term, the charts will be reviewed and for those children who have adhered to the Holy Family High Five for, for example five weeks out of the seven weeks in the half term, they will be invited to participate in a fun activity.

We look forward to exciting year ahead and we cannot wait to share our celebrations with you throughout the year.
