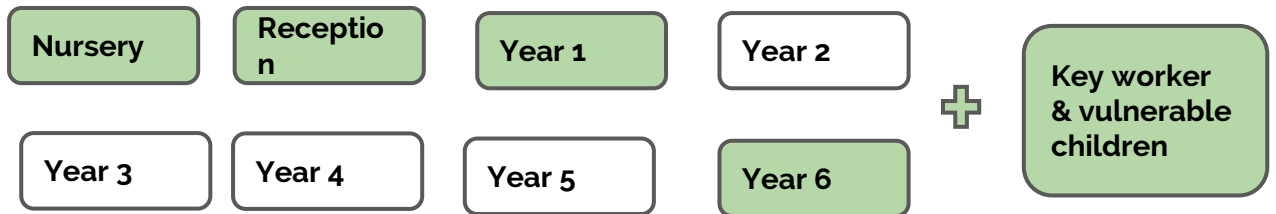




Holy Family Catholic Primary School is reopening

From June 8th we will welcome back children, but only from Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and year 6. School will still be open for key workers' children and vulnerable children.



What are the benefits of children returning to school?



It is good for the children's mental well-being.



It is good for the children to socialise with other children.



School is the best place for them to learn.

What about brothers and sisters?



Only the children in the year groups above.



They can continue with their home learning set by teachers.



How are we making sure school is safe?



We will check for risks before school is open.



Everyone will wash their hands regularly.



If a child or family member is sick they must stay at home.



School will be cleaned regularly.



There will be fewer children in each class.



We may need to make changes to the school day.

Does my child need to attend school?



If your child is well and in one of the specified year groups then they should attend.



There will not be any fines if your child does not come into school.

Will my child be tested?



Yes, if your child shows symptoms of Coronavirus they will be able to be tested.

What if there is a case of Coronavirus in school?



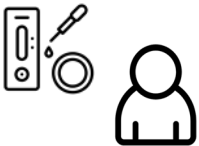

The person with symptoms must self isolate for 7 days.

The people they live with must self isolate for 14 days.

If anyone at school tests positive the whole class must isolate for 14 days.

What else might change?



The way you drop off and pick up your child. You will be asked to keep 2 meters apart when waiting outside of school.



Your child may have a different teacher or classroom. However we will try where possible to keep things consistent.



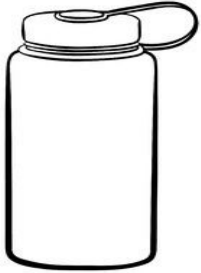
The lessons that are taught.



The way we serve lunch. Children and staff will remain in classrooms for lunch. Any school dinners ordered will be brought to the classroom and classes will be timetabled for use of the playground.



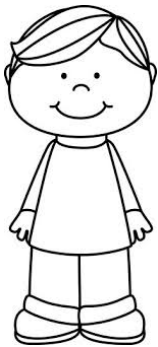
Things to remember if your child is attending school.



If children bring in their own packed lunch, all items must be disposable and will be binned after dinner time.



Children provided with personal stationery packs and are to use the same packs every day.



Children can come to school in their own clothes but please ensure that they have appropriate footwear.
