

Information for parents/carers of Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 children returning to school from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope that you are all keeping safe and well; we cannot wait to see your child(ren) from 8th June.

We have implemented lots of changes to help ensure our children and staff are as safe as possible when they return.

As of Monday 8th June:

- The key worker group will continue to come into school from 8am via the main school entrance (please continue to adhere to the 2 metre social distancing and refrain from entering the key worker building, only children can go inside).
- Reception children will enter school via the main school entrance, the gate will be open from 8:45am-9:15am to support a staggered approach to help you maintain social distancing. Staff will be at the main entrance to greet children and to reinforce social distancing.
- Year 1 and Year 6 will enter school via their usual route, down the big path. As you look at the gates from the road, Year 1 are to walk down the path on the right hand side (along the fence for the field) and Year 6 are to walk down the left hand side, always maintaining 2 metre distance- staff will be on the gate to reinforce this. The gates will be open from 8:45am-9:15am to support a staggered approach.
- Please ensure that only **one** adult brings your child(ren) to school to reduce the number of people in the school area.
- Children will be assigned a desk to work from as of 8th June and will be given a personal stationery pack to use each day.
- Reception and Year 1 children will be provided with lunch.
- Year 6 children are to bring in their own dinner, but all items must be disposable e.g. plastic bag, plastic water bottle. No items are to be brought in and out of school daily.
- The main school building will close at 12:30pm on a Friday to allow time for a deep clean (this does not apply to the key worker building).
- At the end of the school day, Year 1 and Year 6 staff will lead children back to the gate that they entered school and the children will be dismissed. Please ensure whilst you wait on the pavement for your child(ren), that you adhere to the 2 metre social distancing guidance. Year 1 will be dismissed between 3:00pm- 3:15pm and Year 6 will be dismissed between 3:15pm-3:30pm, to again, support a staggered departure in order to reduce the number of people in one area.
- Reception will be dismissed via the main entrance- the gate will be open from 3:00pm-3:15pm. Whilst waiting for your child(ren), please adhere to the social distancing guidance and ensure that only one adult is picking your child up from school, again, to reduce the number of people on the school premises.
- Children can bring in a snack from home, but this must be an item that is completely disposable and that they can open independently.

- Children should bring in a water bottle that can be kept in school and refilled independently. They cannot be taken home (daily or over the weekend) and returned the next day.

Please keep a look out on the school website for our risk assessments and the home/school agreement. In these documents, are actions that we, as a school, will do to help keep everyone safe and also what you are expected to do help ensure this as well.
