Dear Parents/Carers,

I would firstly like to thank you for your continued cooperation and for working with the school to support your child's education. We are living through very difficult times but it is made easier when our school family works together as we currently are.

I would like to take this opportunity to update all parents on the school plan for remote learning if the need arises for pupils to learn at home. Hopefully, this will not occur but I am sure you will agree it is vital that we are fully prepared should the situation arise.

There are many different scenarios which might prompt remote learning to take place. It might be the form of a regional lockdown, a local lockdown or a school lockdown (specific bubbles or whole school). If a lockdown is likely, parents will be contacted immediately. Pupils will then be taught from home following the plan detailed in this letter.

It is important that pupils remain engaged with education, even when they are not on the school premises. Where the school is providing online teaching to pupils who need to learn from home, we expect pupils to access and complete the resources made available to ensure they are not missing out on vital education. However, school understands that each family's circumstances and their access to learning materials for their children differs, and the responsibility to provide educational support at home can be difficult for families. Please know, that school can offer support if there are any difficulties with remote learning.

To ensure pupils continue to receive a high quality education outside of school, the school will monitor pupils' attendance and their engagement with remote learning. In order for remote learning to be successful, it is important that we know who does and does not have access to certain devices at home. Please ensure you have completed and returned the questionnaire sent out on 16th September. If a pupil is unable to engage in remote learning, then parents/carers, should contact the class teacher via Class Dojo as soon as possible.

Thank you once again for your ongoing support should we need to provide remote education for your child. Please do not hesitate in contacting us should you need any advice and support.
